

ATM Security Advice

In view of increasing number of ATM skimming fraud attempts in Hong Kong recently, Public Bank (Hong Kong) Limited ("the Bank") wishes to remind cardholders to be more alert in using Automatic Teller Machines (ATMs).

Cardholder should cover the keypad when entering the Personal Identity Number (PIN) and check whether anyone is trying to peek at your password.

Each ATM of the Bank has a keypad and keypad cover – If customer finds the keypad or cover is damaged or removed, please immediately contact our branch staff.



Four different types of card insert slot have been installed in our ATMs – If customer finds the card insert slot is damaged, altered, removed or installed with any suspicious device, please immediately contact our branch staff.









Count the banknotes immediately after each cash withdrawal. Do not take away any banknotes at the cash dispenser or ATM card at the card insert slot left behind by someone else. Let the banknotes or ATM card return to the ATM automatically.
